ARRIVAL OF HORSES

All horses are stabled at the Helsinki Ice Hall's parking area next to the main Arena.

The truck parking is located at the Southern stadium parking area 300m from the event venue Helsinki Ice Hall.

The Helsinki Stables will open on Thursday 19th October at 12 am. Examination on arrival for horses is on Thursday between 12:00 – 18:00, **address Mäntymäentie 1**, **Helsinki** (parking area next to Olympic Stadium). The examination takes place 400 meters from the stables. The horses will be reloaded after examination and moved to stable area at Pohjoinen Stadiontie. It is also possible to walk the horses from the examination to the stables (5 minute walk).

PLEASE NOTE The examination on arrival for **horses arriving on Wednesday 18 October in late evening, after 10 pm.** takes place at the to the Stable Area, address Pohjoinen Stadiontie 1 (follow National Riders only sign).

If you arrive earlier on Wednesday, please follow the same instructions as given to Thursday arrivals.

Kindly move the trucks to the Horse Truck Parking immediately after unloading according to instructions by the parking guides.

We kindly ask: no trash outside the trashcan. Keep the area clean, thank you!

ENTRY TO SHOWGROUND

Individual badges/bracelets will be issued to riders, grooms and two owners per horse (named in the FEI passport). Additional bracelets may be bought for 150 € each from the Accreditation. Everyone has to receive her/his bracelet personally at the Accreditation office (Main Gate).

DEPARTURE

Departure time of your ferry

Please inform the International Show Office <u>before mid-day on Saturday</u> in order to enable a smooth return traffic after the show.

Departure slot

On Sunday morning you will be allocated a departure slot, based on the given information, for your truck to the road next to stables (Pohjoinen Stadiontie). Horses should leave on Sunday as the demolition of the stables will start then.

HORSE INSPECTION

CSI5*

The horse inspection for **CSI5* jumping horses** is on Thursday at 21:00 in the Warm-up arena. Book Your time for Horse Inspection when you arrive. Booking list is located in the Stable Office. All **stallions** and non-behaving horses, see the booking list.

Re-inspection: Friday morning 7:00.

CDI3*

The horse inspection for **dressage horses** is on Thursday at 21:00 in the Warm-up arena. Book your time at the Stable Office.

VET CERTIFICATE AT DEPARTURE

Inform the vet crew at the vet check that your horse needs the Traces document and fill the document you will get from the venue. The vet check takes place on Thursday 19.10. starting at 21:00. The Traces document will be charged from the rider, and it will cost $50 \in /$ horse.

TIMETABLE

Please <u>check daily</u> timetables, starting orders and results in the International Show Office or http://www.longinestiming.com. They might differ from those in the schedule. **Timetables are subject to changes** (depending on the number of starters)

PRIZE MONEY

Reimbursement of prize money will be paid out by bank transfer per athlete within 14 days after the show. For this purpose the riders are requested to state the bank information: account holders name, company details (name, address, VAT number etc.), name of the bank, IBAN number and SWIFT or BIC code.

PRESS CONFERENCES & MEDIA AVAILABILITY

All riders are requested to attend the press conferences upon request of the Press Officer. The Press Centre is **next to the Main Gate at 1**st **floor**.

Kindly note: The three (3) best riders of the Longines FEI Jumping World Cup™ competition on Sunday are obliged to attend the final press conference. That is immediately after prize giving ceremonies approximately 16:30 (FEI rules, no excuses accepted). All riders are kindly asked to be available upon request for press conference, media interviews and TV-inserts. Thank you!

Saturday Grand Trophy and Sunday World Cup

Each rider, after his/her round is requested to return to the warm-up arena for possible to TV crew to do a short interview. Thank you for your collaboration.

ARENA OPEN FOR RIDING (depends on maintenance)

Please **check Arena timetables daily** in the International Show Office. Please note that the Open Training Session on the Main Arena on Thursday will be open for public. We kindly ask you to be prepared for short interviews as well.

LUNGING FOR HORSES

Please note the lunging ring is in the tent behind the stable area. We hope you find slots for lunging on good co-operation with your groom colleagues. Lunging by booking, one slot/horse/day. Booking sheet is in the Stable Office from 16:00 the day before. Please check Warm Up timetables in the International Show Office.

WARM-UP

Warm-up arena is open only for jumping horses during jumping competition and warm-up, and only for dressage horses during dressage competition and warm-up. Check the exact times at the International Show Office.

Saturday morning during Children's Matiné warm-up is open only for horses participating to Matiné at 08:30-10.15 – sorry for any convenience! Please avoid passing through the backyard.

STABLE AREA

The stables will be closed from 24:00 (or 1 hour after the last class) to 04:30 hrs. In cases of emergency visits to the stable, please call the night duty officer Steward Marie Wheeler at the Stable Office

PLEASE NOTE! For safety reasons, there must be a halter hanged outside each horse's box and a mobile number of the groom/rider.

Smoking in the stable area and inside the Helsinki Ice Hall is strictly forbidden. There is a smoking area outside the stables.

INTERNATIONAL RIDERS TRIBUNE CSI5* + CDI3*

International Rider's **tribune: C6-C7** by the horses in-gate, staircase up from the horses in-gate. Kindly use also level 1 to the tribunes to avoid heavy traffic by the staircase. **Kindly keep the International Tribune for the International Riders only**.

KISS & CRY STAGE

Riders, owners and grooms are requested to <u>use the Kiss & Cry stage</u> right of the horses in-gate when their own horse is performing. This is especially important during the Sunday's Longines FEI Jumping World Cup^{TM} .

RIDERS LOUNGE: CSI5* + CDI3* only

The International Riders Lounge is situated at the warm-up Arena (see map). The entrance is beside the Paddock Club Bar.

HELSINKI INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW "JUMPS GREEN"

Helsinki International Horse Show has followed a sustainability program since 2017. Like last year, Helsinki Horse Show carbon footprint will be calculated. In the venue we have manure processing partner Horseco. All the horse manure is transported to our partner's treatment plant in Tuusula where manure is processed to mulch.

We are committed to reduce and recycle waste at the venue. We choose mainly only eco-friendly materials and we work for green transport choices. We invite all riders and grooms to take part in our project.

Refill water bottles

All grooms will be donated a refill water bottle. Please feel free to use them at the event instead of the disposable bottles. Tap water is safe to drink in Finland. Finnish tap water is fresh and healthy – its quality is among the highest in the world. There we will be a drinking water point in the stable area where all grooms can refill their water bottles.


Recycling






